General information

VENUE

The venue of the European Boys' Team Championship 2014 is Oslo Golf club, situated in the suburban area of the Norwegian capital, Oslo.

The club was founded in 1924, and is the oldest golf club in Norway.

The layout is a parkland course bordering the Bogstad Lake, and the course was rebuilt in 2009 with the design of Steve Forrest and Arthur Hill.

Oslo golf club has hosted several European championships and most recently hosted the European Girls' Team Championship in 2007.

The length of the course from the men's back tee is 6340 meters, par 72.

The Course rating is 74,3 and the slope is 126.

TRANSPORTATION

Transport will be provided for all officials and team members from Oslo Airport (OSL) to the official hotel, subject to notifying the Norwegian Golf Federation by May 18th with flight details. These teams will be met at the OSL airport.

The recommended airport is Oslo airport (OSL) approximately 40 km from the official hotel. If you choose to fly to another airport, your own travel arrangements will have to be made.

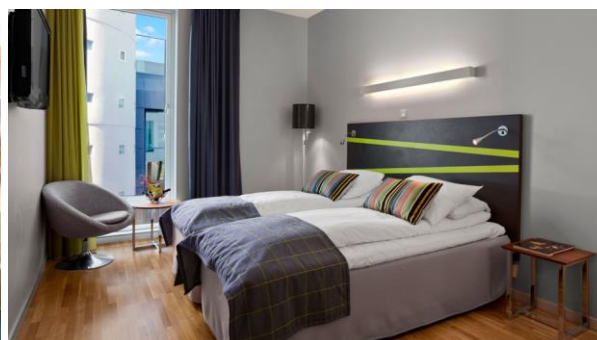
Form 1 - Travel Details should be completed and returned by email NO later than May 18th.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Communications

The use of mobile radio transmitters (walkie-talkies) by the Team Players, Team Captain or Team Advisor is prohibited during the Championship.

Caddies

As per item 1.6 a. in the EGA Conditions of Competition for European Boys' Team Championship, only fellow team players are allowed to act as caddies.

Catering at the golf club

The clubhouse restaurant offers a variety of warm and cold meals and a variety of beverages. Team Managers wishing to set up a catering account must settle direct with Oslo Golf club catering staff to activate this service. Catering accounts must be paid by cash or credit card in advance. Team managers must sign off his account prior to departure.

Players and officials, eligible to charge to an account, will be issued with an identification card. Team managers intending to set-up a catering account must collect identification charge cards from the Information Office.

Dress code

Dress regulations are smart/casual throughout the week i.e. jeans, denim trousers, shorts, sleeveless or collarless shirts, track suits and training shoes are prohibited. Tailored shorts are allowed. Golf shoes are not permitted in the lounge and dining room.

Drug abuse

In order to avoid any misunderstanding in connection with required medication, please check the list of drugs issued by the International Golf Federation (IGF).

Fruit and water

Complimentary fruit will be available on the course on tournament days. Due to environmental concern we encourage the players to drink and refill water from tap. Norwegian tap water is pure, and considered to be equal or better than bottled water.

Golf bags

Storage room for golf bags can be made available. Please contact the Tournament Office upon arrival.



Locker rooms

There is a locker room available in the club house. Each participating team will have access to two lockers for storage of personal belongings.

Liability

Players, officials and guests are reminded that Oslo Golf Club, the Norwegian Golf Federation, The European Golf Association and the official hotels cannot be held responsible for loss of equipment or personal possessions.

Medical care

Medical personnel will be present during the Championship.

Photos

The official photo session will take place on Monday 7th July before the opening ceremony. Team captains will be informed of the exact time.

Pigeon holes

Pigeon holes for the captains' information will be located in the Tournament Office.

Practice

The official practice days are Sunday July 6th and Monday July 7th. Starting lists will be available upon arrival.

Practice facilities

There is a driving range to accommodate players according to a schedule where balls will be provided, in addition there is a short game area on the course and two practice putting greens.

Press office

A wireless network and a copy machine will be available for members of the press at the golf club. All requests regarding press will be handled by the Norwegian Golf Federation on site.

Pro shop

The pro shop is located in the club house next to the starter's house and is well stocked with equipment and clothes.

Registration for the tournament will take place at the counter in the golf club administration, no later than Monday 7th July, 12.00.

- Understanding that as a participant in the European Team Championships (ETC), from 8 to 12 July 2014, I am participating in an exceptional event and, in consideration of the acceptance of my participation therein, I agree to be filmed, televised, photographed, identified and otherwise recorded during the ETC under the conditions and for the purposes now or hereafter authorised by the European Golf Association (EGA) in relation to the promotion of the ETC and the EGA.
- I declare that I have read and that I have full knowledge of the provisions of the Conditions for Championships and that I agree to comply with all such provisions. I further agree to comply with the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy in force at the time of the ETC.
- I declare that I have full knowledge of all such provisions and that all provisions applicable to my participation in the ETC have been specifically brought to my attention by my National Golf Federation (NGF) and are specifically approved by me.
- I agree that all photographs and moving images taken by me at the ETC shall be used solely for personal and non-commercial purposes, unless prior written consent is obtained from the EGA.
- I acknowledge and agree that:
 - I participate in the ETC at my own risk and that I will take all reasonable measures to protect myself from the risks of participation;
 - I am responsible for all property I bring into the ETC sites and that the EGA shall have no responsibility for any loss or damage to this property.
- I irrevocably release the EGA (and their respective members, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, contractors or agents) from any liability (to the extent permitted by law) for any loss, injury or damage that I may suffer in relation to my participation in the ETC.
- I agree that any dispute, controversy or claim arising from, in connection with, or on the occasion of the ETC, not resolved after exhaustion of the legal remedies established by my NGF and the EGA, shall be submitted exclusively to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) in Lausanne, Switzerland, for final and binding arbitration in accordance with the Code of Sports-related Arbitration. The seat of arbitration shall be at Lausanne, Switzerland. The CAS shall rule on its jurisdiction and shall have the exclusive power to order provisional and conservatory measures. The decisions of the CAS shall be final, binding and non-appealable. I shall not, and I hereby waive my right to, institute any claim, arbitration or litigation, or seek any other form of relief in any other court or tribunal.
