VENUE INFORMATION

Club Details

The Duke's is located at the 'Home of Golf' St Andrews, Scotland KY16 8NX.



The Duke's St Andrews has a par of 71 and a standard scratch rating of 76, USGA course rating of 75.8 and USGA slope 140. A spectacular setting above St Andrews, with magnificent panoramic views over the surrounding countryside to the sea.

General Information

The Duke's is highly regarded as one of the finest heathland championship courses in the British Isles and a 'must play' course for any golfer. Its style ranks alongside the great inland challenges which demand accuracy and inventive play as well as power golf.

Designed by Peter Thomson, five-times Open Champion of the 1950s and 1960s, The course was revised and renovated, with five completely new holes, by Tim Liddy in 2006. Tim's philosophy is one of allowing a golf course to 'grow out of the land' rather than be imposed upon it. The course now displays all the hallmarks of the great heathland courses of the early 1920s.

Opened in July 1995 by HRH The Duke of York, Prince Andrew, who played an inaugural round with British Lions and Scottish Rugby Captain Gavin Hastings OBE.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Championship Office

Will be situated in the Administration Compound, adjacent to the clubhouse.

Registration

Players should register upon arrival no later than 1200 hrs on Tuesday 5 August 2014. The registration desk will be situated within the clubhouse.

Catering

The clubhouse will be available for players and team officials. Catering in this area will be available from 06:30 until the last group finish. The remainder of the lounge will be available for spectators and members.

All competitors catering will be at their own expense. Players travelling as a group may set up a catering account on arrival this must be settled direct with the club catering staff before departure. Catering accounts must be paid by cheque, cash or credit card.

Breakfast, coffee and morning rolls will be available from 06:30. Bar snacks and buffet meals will be available from 10:30. Those wishing to dine in the clubhouse in the evening may do so by booking a table in advance with the catering staff.

The same catering facilities will be provided for spectators.

Caddies

Caddies are permitted and must be booked in advance Tel: +44 (0) 1334 470214. There is a limited number available and they will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.

As per item 1.5 in the EGA Conditions of Competition, a competitor is prohibited from having a professional golfer serve as a caddie during any stipulated round.

Changing Facilities & Lockers

Changing facilities are available in the gents and visitor locker room. There are small valuables lockers available which take £1 coins. Showers are available but players are required to bring their own towels.

Trolleys & Yardage Books

Trolleys are available for hire from the professional's shop, on a first come first serve basis. It is advised that trolleys be booked in advance of the Championship. The Scottish Golf Union will provide one yardage book to each competitor.

Practice Round & Facilities

The official practice days are Monday 4 and Tuesday 5 August. Competitors are entitled to one practice round each day, these will be available on a first come first served basis. On these days the course will be open for practice 08:30 – 11:50 & 13:10 – 15:50. During the practice round only one ball shall be in play. Practice rounds must be booked in advance by contacting The Duke's on +44 (0) 1334 470214 between 09:00 and 17:00. Players must report to the starter at the 1st tee before commencing practice. Additional practice rounds can be booked at the discounted rate of £40.

Players may use the golf club practice ground that includes a chipping area. Competitors must not use their own practice balls as balls will be provided.

There is a putting green located next to the starter's hut and a short game area located next to the driving range.

Further practice ground regulations will be distributed on arrival.

Medical Services

The British Red Cross will have a unit situated within the Administration Compound to provide medical assistance.

Press Office

There will be an office made available to all members of the press. This will be situated in a portable unit within the compound area. Please notify The Scottish Golf Union should you have press attendance at the event.

Drug Abuse

A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his performance. Should a competitor show good clinical evidence of use of a non-therapeutic purpose, the Committee may require him to undergo a drug test. Any competitor infringing this condition may be disqualified

Buggies

During the stipulated round, a competitor or accompanying official may not use a motorised vehicle unless specifically authorised by the Championship Committee. This is inclusive of the entire Championship including practice rounds. A copy of the transportation policy is available from the office.

Mobile Phones/DMD's

Distance measuring devices are permitted and the use of mobile phones may also be used during a stipulated round to access information but must not be used for calls on course.

Dress Code

Dress regulations are smart/casual throughout the week i.e. jeans, denim trousers, shorts, sleeveless or collarless shirts, track suits and training shoes are prohibited. Tailored shorts are allowed. Golf shoes are not permitted in the lounge and dining room.

Club Storage

There is a side room that is accessed by pin only that will be available for storing clubs during the day only, please note clubs may not be stored overnight.

The Duke's Golf Club, the Scottish Golf Union and the European Golf Association cannot accept responsibility for player's property during the Championship or on any practice day.
