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CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

EUROPEAN SENIOR MEN'S TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

Conditions of Competition

1. GENERAL

1.1 Eligibility of Teams

Teams are nominated by European Golf Association (EGA) Member National Golf Authorities.

If the number of entries should exceed the maximum (20), the Committee shall decide which teams will be invited to participate based on past participation, past results or both until a Division 2 is officially introduced.

1.2 Eligibility of Players

All players nominated to teams by their national golf authority must be:

- a) male amateur golfers in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A Rules Limited;
 - b) citizens of the country represented. Players with dual citizenship may only represent one country per year;
 - c) playing with a handicap of 9.0 or better.
 - d) 55 years or over as of 0.00 hrs on Day 1 of the Championship.
- Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification of player.

1.3 Format

A maximum of 20 teams shall be eligible to participate and each shall comprise six players.

The Championship comprises two stages played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited, the EGA Generic Conditions, EGA Hand Card and the Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee at the championship.

1.3.1 Stage 1 – Stroke Play

There shall be two rounds of 18 holes stroke play on Days 1 and 2 to decide the draw for the match play, which commences on Day 3.

a) Order of Play

Team captains will determine the order of play within their teams for Days 1 and 2 using the official order of play form. If the order of play form is not submitted to the Committee:

- I. For Day 1, by 17h00 on the day preceding the Championship, the order of play will be determined alphabetically by surname.
- II. For Day 2, by 17h00 on Day 1, the order of play will be the same as for Day 1.

b) Scoring

The lowest five scores from each team's six players will count each day. The aggregate of the five lowest stroke play scores from play on Days 1 and 2 will constitute each team's score for determining the match play stage seeded draw.

c) Decision of Ties

A tie for any place in the match play order shall be decided using the lowest total of the two noncounting scores. If a tie still exists, the sum of the two lowest scores, one from each day, shall be used.

For further ties, the sum of the two second lowest scores, the third lowest scores, the fourth lowest scores and, finally, the sum of the two fifth lowest scores, one from each day, shall be used. Any further tie will be decided based on the final stipulated 18, 9, 6, 3 holes or last hole of the best score from each of the tied teams.

d) Absentee Player

In the event that a registered team member cannot participate in a stipulated stroke play round and is not substituted as permitted in 1.4 (b), the team's five scores will count. In the case of a decision of ties, the team with the absentee player shall finish last. If more than one player is absent, the team shall automatically assume last place in the match play draw.

The remaining players shall be permitted to play their stroke play rounds, which the committee may use to determine match play seeding when more than one team has two or more absentee players.

1.3.2 Stage 2 – Match Play

All teams will play a one foursome and four singles match format. The stroke play will determine a seeded order for the match play. A maximum of 20 teams will be divided into a first flight of eight teams: 1 vs. 8; 2 vs. 7; 3 vs. 6 and 4 vs. 5, second flight of eight teams: 9 vs. 16; 10 vs. 15; 11 vs. 14; and 12 vs. 13 and a third flight of four teams who will play a round-robin with the team qualifying 17th playing the teams qualifying 20th, 19th and 18th on Days 3, 4 and 5 respectively.

If there are fewer than 20 teams, the seeded draw will change according to a standardised EGA structure.

A win in either a foursomes or singles match shall return one point, a halved match, half a point (see 1.3.2 (c)) and a loss, zero points to the team's score. The results of the round robin will be determined based on points accumulated, with one point awarded for a win and zero for a loss. In the event of a tie, the final positions will be decided by the number of individual matches won and, if necessary, by the number of holes won (see 1.3.2 (c) Exception).



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CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

a) Order of Play

On the eve of each match, Team Captains must provide the Committee with the order of play, using the official order of play form, for the foursomes and singles matches:

I. for Day 3 matches, no later than 30 minutes after the completion of the second round of stroke play.

II. for Day 4 and 5 matches, no later than 30 minutes after the completion of their team's flight the previous Day.

Failure to submit the official order of play form on time will result in the order of play being determined alphabetically by surname.

Once the official deadline to submit the order of play form has expired, changes in the order of play are not permitted.

Exception: substitutes : see 1.4 (b).

Penalty for Breach of Condition 1.3.2 (a): Disqualification of all players out of the pre-stated order of play.

b) Halved Match

In the event of a match being all square after 18 holes in any round, players shall continue to play until one wins a hole, when the match will be considered won.

Exception: Condition 1.3.2 (c).

c) Concession of Matches

When a final team match result is already decided, an individual match may be halved if all participants in that match agree.

Note: After 18 holes or any extra hole(s), if the players in an individual match remain all square and the final result of the team match has been decided, the match in question will be halved.

Exception: If the matches are in a flight of three competing nations or in a round robin in the third flight, players must play until there is a winner, extending the stipulated round if necessary.

d) Absentee Players

In the event that one (several) registered team member(s) cannot participate in a stipulated match play round and is not substituted as permitted in 1.4 (b), that (these) player(s)'s match(s) shall be forfeited at a position within the order of play determined according to the following principles.

Foursome matches must not be forfeited and will always be played.

I. If the "withdrawal" occurs before the official deadline to submit the order of play form has expired, the Team Captain will return the order of play form with the absentee player placed in the position of

his or her choice in the singles and that match shall be forfeited.

II. If the "withdrawal" occurs after the official deadline to submit the order of play form has expired,

if the absentee player is listed to play in the singles: his match shall be forfeited,

if the absentee player is listed to play in the foursome, he will be replaced by one of the

players listed to play in the singles. That player will be determined by lot and his single match shall be forfeited.

If fewer than four players are available to represent a team, that team must forfeit its match.

In the event that each team would both have one or more absentee players, all absentee matches would be forfeited and a team match tied result would be decided by stroke play qualification position.

1.4 Substitutions

a) Prior to the Start of the Championship

If a substitute player is required, the Committee must be notified, at the latest, 30 minutes before the first tee time on Day 1. After this deadline, the team must remain with the same players for the entire championship

(exception see 1.4 b). A substitute player is permitted for any reason, but may not participate in the practice rounds until she has been officially substituted for a team member with permission from the Committee.

A breach of this Condition may result in the substitute player not being permitted to compete.

b) After the Start of the Championship

If a substitute player is required, only for reasons of illness, injury or exceptional grounds acceptable to the Committee, the Team Captain, as long as he conforms with the eligibility condition (1.2), will be permitted to become a Playing Captain and he will take the position of the player he substitutes. The Committee must be notified of the substitution no later than 30 minutes prior to the team's first tee time. Once such a substitution has been done, the team will remain with the same players until the end of the championship and the substituted player will not be permitted to compete any more. No other substitutions are permitted.

1.5 Practice

A Team Player, Team Captain or Team Advisor will not be allowed to practice on the championship course for a period of thirty days prior to the first official practice day, unless he or she is a member of the golf club at which the championship is being played.

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CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

Only registered team players and Captain will be permitted to practice during the official practice rounds and in official practice areas.
See Section 1.4. for information on practice for substitutes.

1.6 Advice (Note to Rule 8)

Each team may appoint a "Team Advisor" who may give advice to members of that team from either:

a) a Team Captain, who must be an amateur golfer in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A Rules Limited; or

b) another person who may or may not be a professional golfer. Exception: that person may not walk on a putting green.

If appointed, a Team Advisor must be identified to the Committee prior to the start of the Championship and the position must not be interchanged.

Note: A Team Captain may be named in addition to a Team Advisor. Only the Team Advisor may offer advice.

Please refer to 1.7 for caddying permissions. Any other person accompanying the team is considered as a spectator and should behave accordingly.

Penalty for Breach of Condition: Match Play – Loss of hole; Stroke Play – Two strokes.

1.7 Caddies

A player is prohibited from having a professional golfer serve as his caddie during any stipulated round.

Penalty for Breach of Condition: Match Play – At the conclusion of the hole at which the breach is discovered, the state of the match is adjusted by deducting one hole for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum deduction per round – two holes.

Stroke Play – Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – four strokes (two strokes at each of the first two holes at which any breach occurred).

Match Play or Stroke Play – If a breach is discovered between the play of two holes, it is deemed to have been discovered during play of the next hole and the penalty must be applied accordingly.

A player having a caddie in breach of this Condition must immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred ensure that he conforms with this Condition for the remainder of the stipulated round. Otherwise, the player is disqualified.

1.8 Disqualification

A penalty of disqualification for a breach of the Rules or the Conditions of Competition applies only to the round in which the breach occurred unless otherwise determined by the Committee.

A disqualified team will assume last place in the Championship.

2. PRIZES

2.1 Title and Awards

The winning team of the Championship shall be the European Senior Men's Team Champion for a period of one year. The Championship Trophy shall be held by the winners' National Golf Authority, who will be responsible for the cost of engraving, insuring and maintaining the Trophy and returning it, before the next Championship, to an address named by the EGA Secretary.

The EGA will present medals to the members of the winning team and to the members of the second and third placed teams. Professional golfers nominated as Team Advisors may receive a medal in the absence of a non-playing amateur Team Captain.

The EGA will present the host club with a memento.

The host country will present all participants with a memento.

PLAYER'S INFORMATION



Team Travel Details Form

Team travel details form is duly filled in and returned before 1st of August 2014.

Bus Shuttle Service

Bus shuttle service will be provided free of charge for participants from Lech Walesa Airport Gdańsk upon arrival and departure.

Catering

Buffet breakfast will be served at the Hotels and at the Club House for Guests staying in Sierra Apartments from 7:00 am to 9:30 am. Buffet lunch for Participants and Guests in the Club House amounts to 15 EUR/per person/per day.

Dress Code

A reasonable standard of golf clothes (no jeans) is required at all times on the course and in the club house. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course. Team uniforms are requested for ceremonies.

Practice

A player, Team Captain or Team Advisor who is competing in the European Senior Men's Team Championship by BMW will not be allowed to practice on the championship course for a period of thirty days before the official practice round of the tournament, unless he is a Member of Sierra Golf Club. Practice tee times will be available on Monday 1st of September 2014. Practice balls will be available free of charge at the driving range. Practice balls cannot be used on the championship course.

Golf Bag Storage

Golf bag storage will be available in the Club House.

Locker-Room

Locker-rooms are located in the Club House.

Tournament Office

The tournament office will be situated in the Club House, on the same floor as the locker-rooms.

Registration

The registrations have to be done in the Tournament Office on Sunday 31st August or Monday 1st September 2014 till 12:00 hrs.

Pigeon Holes

The Pigeon Holes will be situated in the Tournament Office.

Communications

The use of mobile radio transmitters (walkie-talkies) by the Team Players, Team Captain or Team Advisor is prohibited during the Championship.

Golf Shop

Golf shop with a limited range of golf equipment and clothing is located in the Club House.

Trolleys

Manual trolleys will be available for 5 EUR/per person/ per day. Please book in advance. Electric trolleys are not available for rent.

Caddies

Caddies will be available for 20 EUR /per person/ per day. Please book in advance.

Payments

Payment can be made in cash in PLN or EUR and by cards: Visa, Master Card, Diners Club. There is no possibility to pay by American Express with chip.

At the players disposals:

- Transfers from Lech Walesa Airport Gdańsk upon arrival, departure and bus shuttle every day between the Hotel Faltom, Hotel Ibis Wasko and Golf Course.
- Practice balls on Driving Range, practice area – putting and chipping.
- Golf bag storage – keys in Reception.
- Locker rooms – keys in Reception.

Weather

The average temperature is between 15 °C and 20 °C.

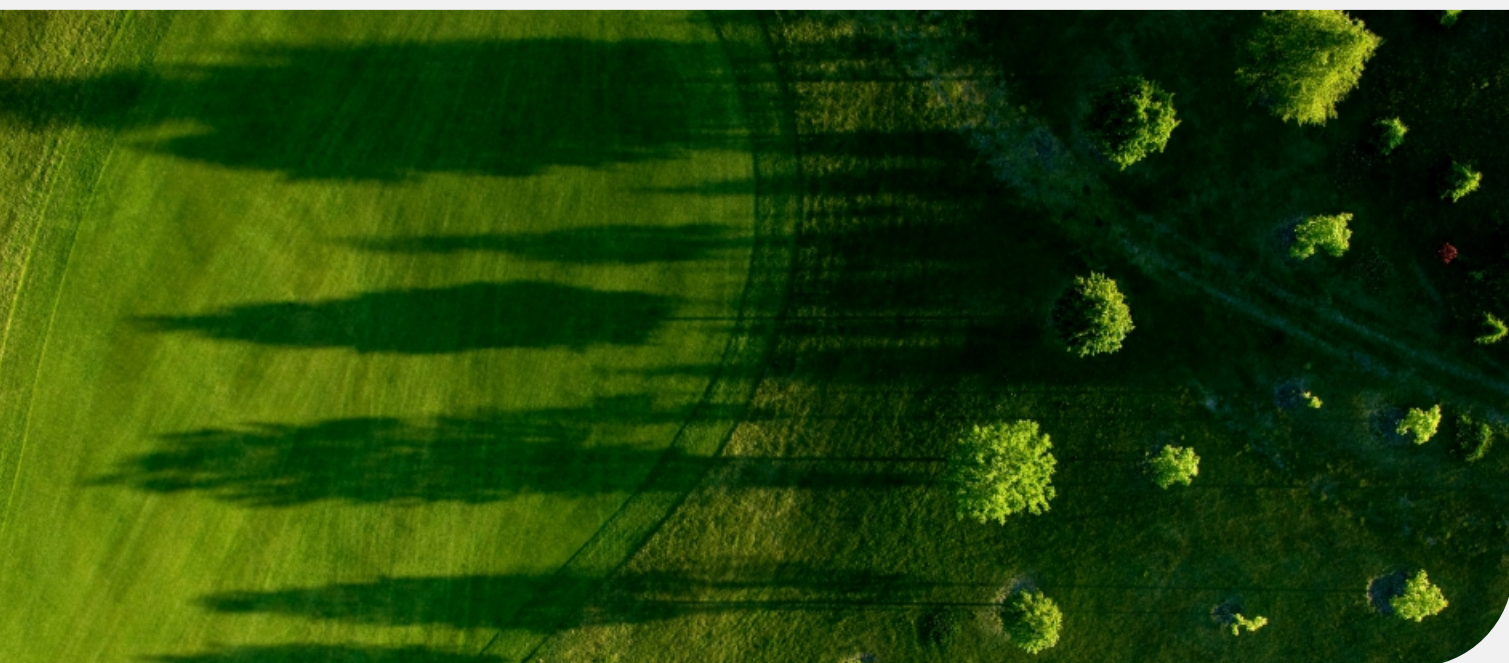

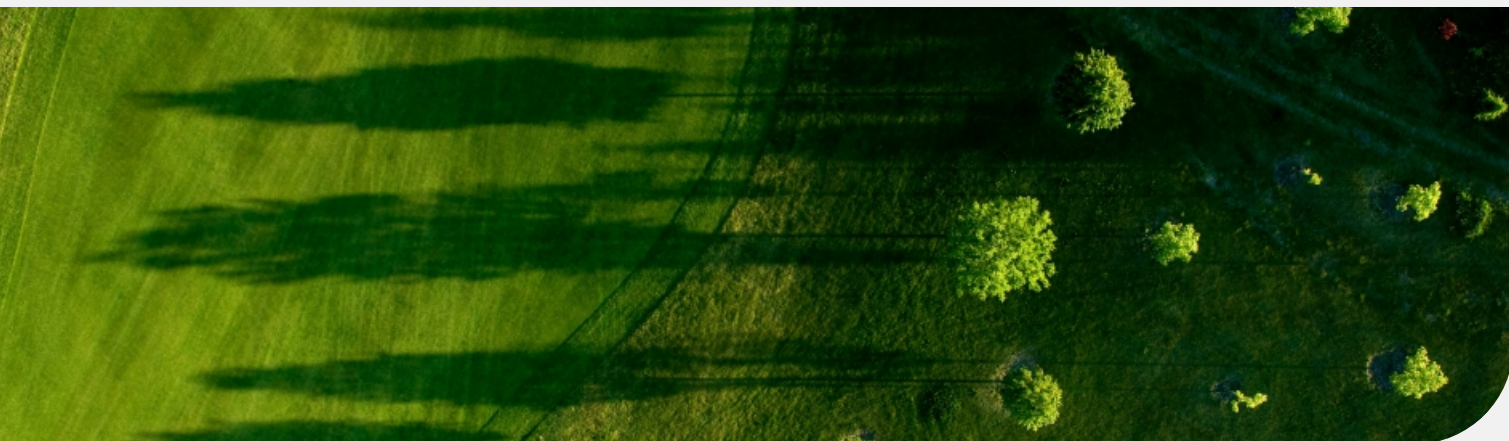

Sierra Golf Club

The Complex Sierra Golf Club is situated in Pętkowice near Wejherowo, on the area of 82 ha, around 25 km from west borders of Tricity.

Sierra Golf Club meets all the world standards, offering a full-scale, 18 holes master class golf course (par 72). Before entering course to play, players can train with the use of a 300-meter driving range with 26 roofed stands, and putting and chipping area.

The course belonging to Sierra Golf Club was founded in 2002 and designed by a Scottish architect, Cameron Sinclair. During preparatory works, the model of the existing relief was created, with the use of the most modern GPS system. Natural lay of the land was expanded into numerous hills and valleys, the streams and backwaters were cleaned and widened. The land of the course was drained, computer and integrated irrigation system was applied on the entire usable area. Sierra Golf Club have 38 self-propelled golf carts with an innovative system „Golf GPS”. It is a device with 11 inches LCD screen and wireless Wi-Fi communication. Such a system supports players by displaying maps, distances, player's location, results, information and advices. It also enables communication with a Club House.

Tournaments and events

Sierra Golf Club hosted many prestigious Tournaments and events.

In 2008 it was chosen to host the first European qualification for the Golf Omega Mission Hills World Cup. It was the first time that qualifications were held in Europe and that the best players from several countries around the world participated.

Every year, SGC is selected as one of the courses on which takes place a Tournament of the Polish Championship Series, which selects the best players in Poland in specific categories.

From 2013 Sierra Golf Club together with Stena Line reached an agreement on the organization of an amateur tournament series under the name Stena Line Golf Amateur Tour. It is a project designed to combine both golf tournament in Sweden and Poland.

In 2013 two tournaments were held, first in August in Karlskrona Golf Club – one of the leading courses in Sweden and the Final in September in Sierra GC. In 2014, the series is increased by other courses in Scandinavia.

We believe that in the long term, it will be one of the biggest Tournament amateur series in this part of Europe.

The Club House

The club house holds an area 1000m², which includes two bars, snooker area and an outdoor terrace. The avenue, planted with chestnut and lime trees leads to the old English club house, with a unique atmosphere.

The players have at their disposal modern equipped cloakrooms with showers, and also two simulators of the newest generation, providing the possibility of playing golf for all year round. Thanks to the simulators, players may observe the route of ball flight after each hit. They have a preview of a golf course with high quality digital image, displayed from a projector.

Restaurant

In the restaurant you may taste Mediterranean cuisine and traditional Polish dishes. The whole menu is accompanied by a choice of healthy, fresh vegetables and fruit juices, and carefully selected wine and champagne list. Certainly, the lovers of single Malt also find a rich choice of excellent drinks.

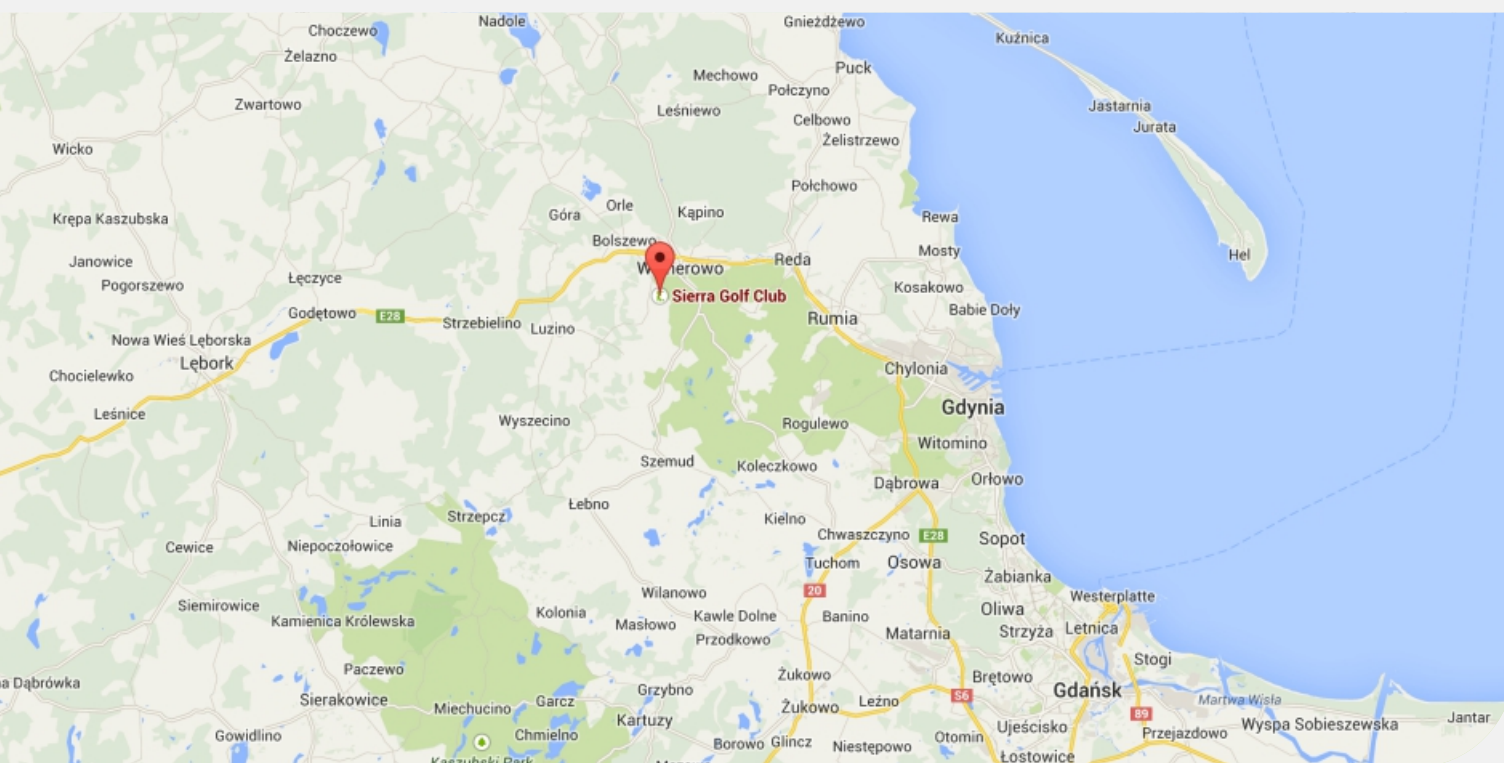
