ENTRIES:

Entries must be submitted ONLINE <http://www.rfegolf.es> by 23:59 hours, 17 February 2021. You can enter through “Inscripciones online / Entries online”



After that, select the championship, click on the box: “I am a foreign player” and fill out

one player's details for the individual and both players' details required for the doubles competition. Only a player of the pairings can submit the entry for the doubles.

Players are responsible to check if their entry form has been accepted. Claims must be submitted within the next 24 hours after the list of participants has been published.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR PARTICIPANTS:

*The championship will take place under the security measures against COVID19 and **THE OFFICIAL COMPETITION GUIDELINES OF THE RFEG.***

Among these measures, a VIRTUAL scorecard will be used. Each participant will receive a link from which they will have access to their scorecards throughout the tournament. The sending of this unique link - which each participant must keep private - will be done by SMS to the mobile phone number indicated in the online registration, and will be used to enter scorecard results (player and marker). **Please note that the National Federations that register players, have to indicate the email address and mobile number of each player in each entry form.***

***The player must ensure that both her mobile phone number and her email address - which appear on the online registration screen - are up to date.** If they are not correct, the player can change them by accessing, on that same screen, to "Edit Personal Information", save new data and then return to "Online registration". However, the player may request the tournament office to send a new access link or update her mobile number if necessary.*

It is recommended that players enter the results hole by hole, make sure they have their mobile fully charged at the beginning of each day and keep it muted at all times.

**Exceptionally, disinfected scorecards will be available for those players who need them.*

WITHDRAWALS AND WAITING LIST:

Notifications of withdrawal must be made by phone or email to rfegolf@rfegolf.es by 12:00 am two days before the competition starts. **From Monday 1st March 2021 on**, only the players on the waiting list who have confirmed availability to play by email to elena.vecino@rfegolf.es, will be called to cover last-minute withdrawals. The players who have not done so will be definitively withdrawn.

REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEES:

Players must pay their entry fee at the ProShop of Club Zaudín Golf, and complete registration at the championship office, upon arrival at the club on the official practice day and **before using any golf facilities**. Registration deadline: 12:00 hours on the eve of the start of the championship.

Entry fee: EUR 75,00 per player per championship. This fee includes the temporary license required by the RFEG Statutes and the insurance attached to the license, subscribed by the Regional Federation where the competition takes place.

ACCREDITATIONS:

An antigen COVID19 test will be carried out on participants, companions and the personnel involved in the competition. The test will be free for all participants, the companions must pay the stipulated price. Once the test is done, all participants must return to their vehicles and stay there until they receive an SMS communicating the result of the test (about 15 minutes). Once the result has been received, and if it is negative, they should go to the registration area, before accessing any other area of the facility.

As part of the registration in the club, the RFEG will require each participant to deliver to the Championship Committee the **Responsible Declaration** (pages 4 & 5) and the **Personal Location Form** (page 6), duly completed in all its sections and signed. Whoever fails to comply

with this requirement will not be able to participate. In the same way, coaches, federation representatives, organization personnel, and **a single companion per player**, must deliver both duly completed documents to the Championship Committee to obtain the accreditation to access the club's facilities.

CONDITIONS: (In pages 7 & 8) Caddies not allowed.

ELECTRIC TROLLEYS AND BUGGIES:

The club has a limited amount of electric trolleys and buggies available.
Players can book them by email (info@clubzaudingolf.com / reservas@clubzaudingolf.com) or by phone **before February 17**.

Price Electric Trolley per day : 12 EUR
Price Buggy per day: 30 EUR

Buggies will be distributed so there will be no more than 2 buggies per match.
Bookings will be awarded on a first come first served basis.

DRESS CODE:

The player is responsible for compliance with the Dress Code of the Club where the competition is held or, in the absence of it, for wearing appropriate clothing.

ANTI-DOPING POLICY:

All players are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy. Details of the Policy and the current List of Prohibited Substances and Methods are available from the International Golf Federation's website (www.igfgolf.org). Players who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the IGF knowing that, should a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) be required this must be submitted to the IGF not later than 30 days before the start of the Championship. RESPONSIBLE DECLARATION

best appropriate.

I DECLARE UNDER MY OWN RESPONSIBILITY

1. That I have full knowledge and awareness that the practice of the sport of Golf both in training and in meetings implies a risk contagion of COVID-19 of which I am aware and accept, with the understanding that I will have the right to be able to present the appropriate claims against those people who have breached the protection and communication rules established in the protocols, especially when they have been an athlete who have participated in the meeting.
2. That I do not present compatible symptoms with the SARS-CoV-2 Coronavirus (fever greater than or equal to 37.5 degrees, cough, general malaise, feeling short of breath, loss of taste, headache, fatigue, neck pain, pain muscle, vomiting, diarrhoea) or any other typical symptoms of infections.
3. That I have not tested positive or had close contact with any person or persons with possible or confirmed symptoms of COVID-19 in the 14 days immediately prior to the date of signing of this document.
4. That I have read the security protocols and the information and prevention measures for hygiene and security of COVID-19 established by the organizer of the competition and the meeting and I agree to comply with them in a responsible manner, in their entirety, with the guidelines of conduct and behavior that are established there, accepting that the Hygiene Manager of the event can agree on his own accord my exclusion from the competition and from the installation or limited area of the sports space in case of non-compliance.
5. That I am aware and accept that non-compliance with the rules of COVID-19 especially the non-declaration of having tested positive or not having declared the fact of having had a close relationship with people with symptoms implies a very serious infraction of the disciplinary code that can lead to a sanction of exclusion from the competition and the loss of the sports license for the entire season.
6. That I promise to inform the club and the Federation (before any match) of any symptoms that are compatible with COVID-19, the fact of having tested positive or the existence of any presumed or

confirmed case of covid-19 in the family or close environment and I promise to keep the club managers promptly informed of their evolution.

This information will be treated confidentially and for the sole purpose of being able to adopt the necessary measures to prevent the contagion and spread of the virus. By completing this document, the undersigned grants express consent for the Spanish Golf Federation to process these data from a strictly medical point of view and prevention.

At the same time, and by signing this document, you declare to know the specific protection and hygiene measures established in the Protocol of the CSD (Spanish Sports Council) and of the Spanish Golf Federation whose rules are mandatory for participants in official sports competitions of Golf and for all the clubs affiliated to the Federation that participate in them.

Compliance with the aforementioned rules is an individual responsibility of each of the participants and the club or entity that organizes the meeting, without there being any responsibility on the part of the Spanish Golf Federation contagions “that could occur on the occasion of the competition being disputed”. CONDITIONS SPANISH INTERNATIONAL DOUBLES SENIOR LADIES' AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

Eligibility:

All Amateur Ladies who have reached their 50th birthday on or before December 31 of the year of the championship, who have their National Federation or Union membership card, and with a maximum handicap of 18.4, shall be eligible to participate. Entries are limited to the 44 double teams of competitors with the lowest aggregate exact handicap. Ties for 44th place will be resolved by entry date. All winning teams from previous editions of this championship may participate, regardless of what their handicap might be. If any of these teams' aggregate handicaps were higher than the 44 accepted entries, they will increase this number. The Women's Amateur Technical Committee of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation reserves the right to increase the number of competitors by two invitations, with no handicap limitation.

Exceeding entries will be placed on a waiting list ordered by handicap. In case of ties, players registered earlier will be included.

Any team not willing to participate for any reason must notify the Championship Committee at the Golf Club or to the Ladies Amateur Technical Committee of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation by 12:00 a.m. two days before the competition starts. Otherwise, none of the two competitors will be able to participate in the following year's edition. In addition, they will be obliged to pay the entry fee or they will no longer be able to participate in any RFEF competition until this payment is cleared.

Participants are allowed to ride motorised carts.

Format:

36 holes Stroke Play Scratch over two rounds. First day: 18 holes Fourball and second day: 18 holes Foursome. Participants will play from the tee-boxes established by the championship committee.

The team with the lowest aggregate score will be the International Double's Senior Ladies Amateur Champion of the event. An additional handicap trophy will also be given.

In the event of a tie for the Championship title, the winner shall be decided on a hole-by-hole play-off. The Championship Committee will lay down, before the beginning of the last round, the order of the holes to play; otherwise, the natural order of the course will prevail. For trophy purposes, all other ties will be resolved using the R.F.E.G Green Book criteria. This means ties for scratch prizes will be resolved in favor of the team with the highest sum of playing handicaps, and ties for the handicap prize in favor of the team with the lowest sum. If still tied, it will be decided by card count back using the last 18, 27, 30, 33, 34 and 35 holes, compared under the same Calculation Formula in which the tournament was played, this is, gross hole results for scratch prizes and net hole results for handicap prize; if the tie persists, it will be decided by lot.

Entries:

Entry forms have to be submitted online through www.rfegolf.es by the announced closing date. The entry fee must be paid upon registration at the Golf Club.

Starting times:

The starting times will be established by the Championship Committee.

Prizes:

The trophies will be provided by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation to:

- The scratch team Champion
- The scratch team Runner-up
- The scratch team in 3rd place
- The handicap team Champion (*Non-cumulative with any of the scratch trophies which have priority over this handicap trophy)

The Championship Committee reserves the right to alter the regulations and conditions of the competition.

CONDITIONS SPANISH INTERNATIONAL INDIVIDUAL SENIOR LADIES' AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

Eligibility:

All Amateur Ladies who have reached their 50TH birthday on or before December 31 of the year of the championship and who have their National Federation or Union membership card, shall be eligible to participate. Maximum handicap allowed 18.4. Entries are limited to the 90 competitors:

- a) 80 players with the lowest exact handicap
- b) Next 7 players with Spanish Nationality, and with the lowest handicaps, not included in a), in both cases in the event of applications with the same handicap for the last position, they will be decided by ballot.
- c) The Women's Amateur Technical Committee of the Royal Spanish Golf Federación reserves the right to increase the number of competitors by three invitations, without handicap limitation.

In addition to these 90 players, winners from previous editions of the tournament may be eligible to play, regardless their handicap.

Unaccepted entries will be placed on an ordered by handicap waiting list. In case of ties, players registered earlier will have priority.

An entrant not willing to participate for any reason must notify the Championship Committee at the Golf Club or to the Ladies Amateur Technical Committee of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation by 12:00 a.m. two days before the competition starts. Competitors failing to do this will not be able to participate in the following year's edition. In addition, they will be obliged to pay the entry fee or they will no longer be able to participate in any RFEF competition until this payment is cleared.

Participants are allowed to ride motorised carts.

Format:

A 54-hole Stroke Play Scratch played over three rounds of 18 holes each day. **Only players returning the 60 lowest scores and ties over 36 holes shall qualify for the final round.** Participants will play from the tee-boxes established by the championship committee.

In the event of a tie for first place Scratch, the winner shall be decided after a hole-by-hole play-off. The championship committee will lay down, before the beginning of the last round, the order of the holes to play; otherwise, the natural order will prevail. For trophy purposes, all other ties will be resolved using the R.F.E.G Green Book criteria. This means ties for scratch prizes will be resolved in favor of the player with the highest playing handicap, and ties for the handicap prizes in favor of the player with the lowest. If still tied, it will be decided by card count back using the last 27, 36, 45, 48, 51, 52 and 53 holes, compared under the same Calculation Formula in which the tournament was played, this is, gross hole results for scratch prizes and net hole results for handicap prizes; if the tie persists, it will be decided by lot. If for any reason, any of the established categories failed to have any players competing after the cut, results before the cut will be considered final for that category.

Categories:

- 1st category: Any competitor regardless of her handicap.
- 2nd category: competitors with a handicap index of 4.5 or higher.
- 3rd category: competitors with a handicap index of 11.5 or higher.
- Age Category 60 and over: players who have reached their 60th birthday on or before the 31st of December of the championship year.
- Age Category 70 and over: players who have reached their 70th birthday on or before the 31st of December of the championship year.

Any given category must have a minimum of six players.

Entries:

Entry forms have to be submitted online through www.rfegolf.es by the announced closing date. The entry fee must be paid upon registration at the Golf Club.

Starting Times:

Starting times will be established by the Championship Committee.

Prizes:

Trophies will be provided by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation to:

- The scratch Winner
- The scratch Runner-up
- The scratch in 3rd position.
- The 1st, 2nd, 3rd position scratch on the 2nd and 3rd category.
- The 1st place handicap in each category.
- The 1st Scratch position in age category 60 and over and the 1st Scratch position in age category 70 and over.

Individual prizes will be non-cumulative. Priority is given to the overall prizes and to the scratch prizes over the handicap.

The Championship Committee reserves the right to alter the regulations and conditions of the competition if advisable reasons exist.
