Practice times must be requested to Parador El Saler, once the list of participants has been published.

The Championships Conditions are enclosed to this information on page 4 (Double) and Page 5 (Individual).

ENTRIES: Entries must be submitted ONLINE <http://www.rfegolf.es> by 23:59 hours, February 9th, 2021
Entries failing this condition will not be accepted.

For Spanish Players, the official exact handicap to make the list of accepted players will be listed in the database of the RFEG at 10:00 a.m. the day after the closing date. For Foreign Players, the official exact handicap used for all purposes will be the certified handicap at date of entry for their National Golf Federation, Union or Association.

Players should select the competition, click on **“entries online”**

After that, the player must click on the box: “I am a foreign player” and fills player’s details required for the competition.

You can also require your federation to submit your entry form on your behalf. Players are responsible to check if her entry form is accepted. Any claims must be submitted within the next 24 hours after the list of participants is published.

The list of accepted players and the waiting list (if any) will be published at the web site of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation (www.rfegolf.es) from the day after the closing date.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR PARTICIPANTS:

The championship will take place under the security measures against COVID19. **(Official Competitions Guidelines RFEG).**

Among these measures, the use of the VIRTUAL RESULT CARD (*) will be sent to each participant through a link from which they will have access to their game cards throughout the tournament. The sending of said unique link, which each participant must keep private, will be made by SMS to the mobile phone number indicated in the online registration, the day before the first day of competition and will serve to enter their results and those of the player who goes to mark.

The player must ensure **that both his mobile phone number and his email address - which appear on the online registration screen - are up to date.**

Players are recommended to enter the results hole by hole and make sure they have their mobile fully charged at the beginning of each day, keep it muted at all times and in airplane mode while no data is entered.

() Telematic cards should be used preferably, although disinfected scorecards will be available for those players who exceptionally need them.*

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:

Due to the Covid-19 situation, the RFEG is forced to adjust the field. (See Conditions: Pages 7 y 8)

WITHDRAWALS:

According to the Royal Spanish Golf Federation, if any registered player cannot participate for any reason, they must notify it by phone (915 552 682) or in writing to the email of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation: rfegolf@rfegolf.es, before 12:00 hours the day before the start of the Championship. Whoever fails to comply with this requirement will not be able to take part in the next edition of this test. In addition, you will be obliged to pay the registration fee and, if you do not do so, you will not be able to register in any test of the Federation until you pay off your debt.

ENTRY FEES:

Entry fees should be paid upon arrival at the Golf Club.

- **Entry Fee: 75, 00 € per player**
- **Entry Fee: 150,00 € per Team**

(This fee includes the temporary license required by the RFEG Statutes and the insurance attached to the license, subscribed by the Regional Federation where the competition takes place).

REGISTER OF PLAYERS:

The register of players and the pay of the entry fee will be made in the golf club jointly, within the time and place established by the Championship Committee.

Players must register **before 12:00 hours on the day before the Championship.**

Players who cannot go to the club on the official practice day and, as such, cannot register and pay the fee by the deadline, **should contact the secretary of the club caddymaster@melia.com to confirm their participation in the championship conclusively. Failure to do so, the Championship Committee may replace the player for the appropriate waiting list (if any).**

ACCREDITATIONS:

In addition to registering with the club, the RFEG will require each participant and a single companion, as well as the technicians and organization personnel, to obtain an accreditation. To do this, they must present themselves at the TOURNAMENT OFFICE, before 12:00 hours on the eve of the Championship, to deliver to the Competition Committee the **Declaration and Personal Location Forms** that appears on the following sheets, duly completed in all its sections and signed . Whoever fails to comply with this requirement will not be able to participate.

I DECLARE UNDER MY OWN RESPONSIBILITY

1. That I have full knowledge and awareness that the practice of the sport of Golf both in training and in meetings implies a risk contagion of COVID-19 of which I am aware and accept, with the understanding that I will have the right to be able to present the appropriate claims against those people who have breached the protection and communication rules established in the protocols, especially when they have been an athlete who have participated in the meeting.
2. That I do not present compatible symptoms with the SARS-CoV-2 Coronavirus (fever greater than or equal to 37.5 degrees, cough, general malaise, feeling short of breath, loss of taste, headache, fatigue, neck pain, pain muscle, vomiting, diarrhoea) or any other typical symptoms of infections.
3. That I have not tested positive or had close contact with any person or persons with possible or confirmed symptoms of COVID-19 in the 14 days immediately prior to the date of signing of this document.
4. That I have read the security protocols and the information and prevention measures for hygiene and security of COVID-19 established by the organizer of the competition and the meeting and I agree to comply with them in a responsible manner, in their entirety, with the guidelines of conduct and behavior that are established there, accepting that the Hygiene Manager of the event can agree on his own accord my exclusion from the competition and from the installation or limited area of the sports space in case of non-compliance.
5. That I am aware and accept that non-compliance with the rules of COVID-19 especially the non-declaration of having tested positive or not having declared the fact of having had a close relationship with people with symptoms implies a very serious infraction of the disciplinary code that can lead to a sanction of exclusion from the competition and the loss of the sports license for the entire season.
6. That I promise to inform the club and the Federation (before any match) of any symptoms that are compatible with COVID-19, the fact of having tested positive or the existence of any presumed or confirmed case of covid-19 in the family or close environment and I promise to keep the club managers promptly informed of their evolution.

This information will be treated confidentially and for the sole purpose of being able to adopt the necessary measures to prevent the contagion and spread of the virus. By completing this document, the undersigned grants express consent for the Spanish Golf Federation to process these data from a strictly medical point of view and prevention.

At the same time, and by signing this document, you declare to know the specific protection and hygiene measures established in the Protocol of the CSD (Spanish Sports Council) and of the Spanish Golf Federation whose rules are mandatory for participants in official sports competitions of Golf and for all the clubs affiliated to the Federation that participate in them.

Compliance with the aforementioned rules is an individual responsibility of each of the participants and the club or entity that organizes the meeting, without there being any responsibility on the part of the Spanish Golf Federation contingencies "that could occur on the occasion of the competition being disputed". CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS:

All amateur players, male, Senior category, who are at least 50 years old in the year in which the event is held, may take part, with the limitations that are subsequently expressed, with a valid license issued by their corresponding National Federation

The championship will be contested by the 44 couples, registered in a timely manner, that have the lowest exact handicap sum, using the exact handicap that appears in the RFEG database first thing in the morning after the registration deadline. (For foreign players, the official exact handicap used for all purposes will be the certified handicap at date of entry for their National Golf Federation, Union or Association. In the event of a tie for 44th place, the couple that has previously registered for the competition will participate. With the registered couples excluded, a waiting list will be established in order of exact handicap that will be used to cover possible losses. The criteria to be followed to establish the order of priority, among the players on the waiting list with the same exact handicap, will also be the earliest registration date.

They will also be able to participate, regardless of what their handicap is, all the Champion Couples of this championship in their previous editions. These, if they have a handicap higher than that admitted in the 60 couples with the lowest handicap, will increase the figure to 60 in order not to remove a place from any of the rest of the participants.

If for any reason, a registered couple cannot participate, they must notify the Royal Spanish Golf Federation in writing before 12:00 hours the day before the start of the Championship. In no case can the couples be changed once the entry date is over. According to the provisions of the Board of Directors of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation, in all the tests of the Spanish Federation, registered players who cannot take part and do not make it known within the established deadlines, will not be able to participate in it in their next edit, neither player. In addition, both will be obliged to pay the registration fee and, if they do not do so, they will not be able to register for any Federation test until their debt is settled. Likewise, all players must confirm their participation in person in the Club, no later than 12:00 hours on the eve of the start of the Championship. In case of not being able to appear before the established term, you must confirm your participation by telephone or in writing to the Royal Spanish Golf Federation; otherwise, the Test Committee may substitute the Player for the one corresponding to the waiting list.

- Golf Carts will be allowed and should be shared in order to avoid more than two buggies in each match.

FORMAT:

Stroke Play Scratch over two rounds of 18 holes each day. First day 18 holes-Best Ball and second 18 holes Greensome. Participants will play from yellow marks.

The scratch winner will be considered the winner team.

In the event of a tie for the first place, the winner shall be decided by a sudden death play-off. The championship committee will lay down the order of the holes to play. If it is not fixed, the natural order will prevail. All the ties for the runner up position will be considered ex-aequo. Any draw for every spot will be resolved, according to the Green Book of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation (*at scratch classification will be awarded to the highest playing handicap team*).

ENTRIES:

Entries must be submitted ONLINE (www.rfegolf.es). The entry fee of 75, 00€ per player (*150, 00€ per team*) will be paid upon arrival at the Golf Club, before the tournament.

STARTING TIMES:

First competition day: the order will be established by the Championship Committee. The order on the second day will be by classification.

PRIZES:

The Scratch Champion team will award a trophy that will be provided by Royal Spanish Golf Federation.

The Scratch runner-up team will award a trophy. All the ties for the runner-up position will be considered ex-aequo. The trophy for the runner-up will be awarded to the highest playing handicap team of competitors.

The Championship Committee reserves the right to amend the Rules or Conditions, should this be deemed necessary

CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS:

All amateur players, male, Senior category, who are at least 50 years old in the year in which the event is held, may take part, with the limitations that are subsequently expressed, with a valid license issued by their corresponding National Federation

The number of participants may not exceed 90 players, which will be:

- The first **20 players and ties of the 2019 Spanish Senior National Ranking** (due to Covid-19 there has been no Ranking 2020) and **the winners of previous editions**, regardless of the current handicap will have automatic access to the Championship, provided they have registered for the Championship.

- The remaining participants up to 90 participants will be selected as follows:

- **Up to the 55th participant in strict order of exact handicap**, using the exact handicap that appears in the RFEG database first thing in the morning after the registration deadline. (For foreign players, the official exact handicap used for all purposes will be the certified handicap at date of entry for their National Golf Federation, Union or Association) in case of a tie of different players with the same handicap, the criteria to be followed will be the one of the earliest registration date.

- **The 15 players, registered, of Spanish nationality** (with a Spanish license) with the lowest exact handicap that have not entered among the 55 participants of the previous paragraphs. If in the figure of 15 different players are tied with the same handicap, the criteria to be followed will be that of the earliest registration date. If there is a greater number of registrants, a waiting list will be prepared for an exact Handicap (**regardless the nationality**) to cover, one by one, the possible substitutions in this section.

In case of applications exceeding this number, entries for the highest exact handicap competitors will be decided by order of registration. If a competitor is not able to participate, for any reason, he must communicate his decision to the Championship Committee at the Club or to the Men Amateur Technical Committee of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation before 12:00 a.m. of two days before the starting of the championship. Competitors failing to do this will not be able to participate in the 2 following year's edition. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed immediately after the closing date and will be placed on a reserve list, by exact handicap order, and given the opportunity to compete if there are subsequent withdrawals. The possible reported absences in the specified period will be covered one by one. The used criteria for establishing priorities among players with the same exact handicap on the reserve list will be the earliest date of registration.

- Exact Handicap Limit: 18, 4.
- Golf Carts will be allowed and should be shared in order to avoid more than two buggies in each match.

FORMAT:

Over three rounds of 18 holes Stroke Play each day. Participants will play from yellow marks. After the 2nd round, a cut will be established with the first 60 qualified players and ties will qualify for the 3rd round. The scratch winner will be considered the winner.

In the event of a tie for the first place, the winner shall be decided by a sudden death play-off. The championship committee will lay down the order of the holes to play. If it is not fixed, the natural order will prevail. All the ties for the runner up position will be considered ex-aequo. The runner – up trophy will be awarded to the highest playing handicap player.

For the Scratch categories, the three rounds will count. If any representative of the 2nd or 3rd scratch category does not qualify for the 3rd round, the final classification of these categories will be established after the 2nd round.

CATEGORIES:

The Categories will be Scratch. To compete in a category must have a minimum of six players participating.

ENTRIES:

Entries must be submitted ONLINE (www.rfegolf.es). The entry fee of 75, 00 € will be paid upon arrival at the Club House, before the tournament.

STARTING TIMES:

The starting times will be established by the Championship Committee.

PRIZES:

Trophies will be provided by Royal Spanish Golf Federation:

- Champion.
- Runner-up. All the ties for the runner-up position will be considered ex - aequo. The trophy for the runner-up will be awarded to the highest playing handicap player.
- 3rd classified scratch
- 1st Spanish Player classified. Will be accumulative.

Scratch Prizes will be accumulative.

The Championship Committee reserves the right to amend the Rules or Conditions, should this be deemed necessary.
