Continent of Europe Team

The Continent of Europe team will comprise the following players to compete for the inaugural Under-16s Girls' Match to be played in conjunction with the Vagliano Trophy in Wales this week:



For the first time, the Vagliano Trophy teams of Great Britain and Ireland and the Continent of Europe will have the company of a separate title, six-a-side, under-16 girls' match.

The Continental team comprises:

Shannon Aubert (France) plays much of her golf in the US, finishing runner up in both the 2010 American Junior Golf Association Girls' Championship and PING Invitational. Closer to home, she won the Cartier Trophy in the same year. Karolin Lampert (Germany) was this year's recipient of the latter and was runner-up in the German Girls' Championship. Her compatriot, Quirine Eijkenboom, won the German Golf Association's Match Play Championship, while Emily Pedersen (Denmark) showed her potential by winning her country's equivalent.

Ha Rang Lee and Clara Baena are Spain's national under-16 girls champion and runner-up, respectively. Clara achieved one place better in the North of England under-16s last year.

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
