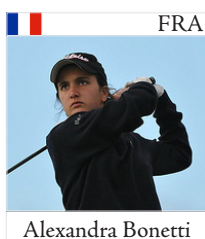

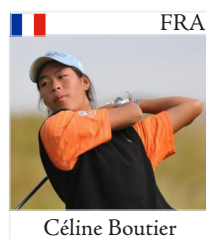

The strong Continent of Europe team heading for Wales this week includes the current International European Amateur Champion, Sophia Popov (Germany) and last week's Ladies' British Open Amateur Championship finalist, Alexandra Bonetti (France). Popov has continued her good form from her US college base this year taking PAC-10 individual honours and winning the Ping/ASU Invitational.

Also competing across the Atlantic, Céline Boutier is this year's ANNIKA Invitational Champion, Therese Kolbaek (Denmark) won the Mountain West Conference Championship and Marta Silva (Spain), the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic.

Here in Europe, Camilla Hedberg (Spain) won Copa RCG Sotogrande from her new team-mate, Lara Katzy (Germany), before leading the qualifiers into the Ladies' British Open Amateur. Madelene Sagström (Sweden) edged-out local Manon Gidali (France) for the French International Lady Juniors' Championship (Esmond Trophy).

Competing together, the Continent of Europe team enjoys five of the top ten European World Women's Amateur Golf Rankings. The team from Great Britain and Ireland holds three.
