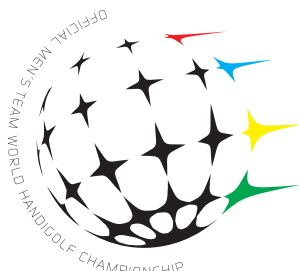


WELCOME TO MALMÖ - SWEDEN FOR THREE MAJOR EVENT'S

SWEDISH INVITATIONAL 12-13 AUGUST 2011, BOKSKOGENS GC



The 3rd edition of Swedish Invitational will be played at Bokskogens GC on the 12 and 13 of August 2011. The championship is played at scratch and are open for all types of disabled golf players. The championship has been arranged two times before and on each occasion has been considered the "unofficial WC". Johan Kammerstad, Sweden won the tournament in 2006 and in 2008 Manuel Del Los Santos from France triumphed. Many of the world's best disabled golfers have participated in the tournament through the years. Swedish Invitational 2011 will gather the world's elite. Players will be invited separately in accordance with a wide range of disabilities and nationalities.

MALMÖ WORLD HANDIGOLF CONFERENCE 4-5 AUGUST 2011, MALMÖ, SWEDEN



One of the goals for this Conference is to introduce the International Golf Federation (IGF) / IGF Paralympic Golf Committee as the governing body for the inclusion of Golf as a New Sport in the Paralympic Sports Programme, including the Classification Code for Golf as required under the International Paralympic Committee regulations. All the 185 nations that are members in the IPC will be invited together in the (disabled) world of Golf. If In November 2010 the IPC decide to include Golf in the 2016 Paralympic Sports Programme, the meeting in Malmö will gather many organizations from around the world.

GENERAL INFORMATION



Bokskogens Golf Club was founded in 1963 and is one of Sweden's premier golf destinations. The two 18 hole courses are located in a stunning parkland area between Torup and the lake Yddingen, 20 minutes by car from Malmö center. The Old course, "The championship course", has been host over the years for many Professional and European Tour events and has recently undergone an extensive re-construction, proving now to be an even more demanding test. The new course, "The nature course", is with the more undulated setting an astonishing experience of nature. The greens on the New Course were reconstructed as late as 2005. The club also has a driving range, chipping areas and a smaller practice course with four plus six holes.

The clubhouse – a great refurbished old typical "Skåne" grey stone building contains dressing rooms, a large restaurant, Pro shop, conference rooms among others.

FIFH (The Club Sport for disabled) is the country's largest sports club for people with disabilities. The club was founded 1956 and is one of Sweden's oldest clubs for disabled athletes. The Malmö club hosts every years since 1977, "Malmö Open", a competition that yearly gathers 2500 competitors from 25 nations. FIFH runs its own sports facility "FIFH Halle" in central Malmö. The sports centre is a meeting point for people with disabilities in the Malmö area, Skåne and Öresund. The club has a spoken compliance strategy and a large part of the recruiting work is about to mirror the city of Malmö as a whole. The club is very active with Youth and juniors and runs many sports schools and Trial activities around the city. The group with older people with disabilities is also a large target group with many activities. Over these areas there are a huge exercise and elite organization that every year produces National Team athletes. FIFH is not only sports, but also girl groups, environmental work and work with physical and informative availability as a large information project to put the target group at the society map, is also a daily work.

The club athletes every year bring home medals from World Championships. Every second year it's medals from the summer/winter Paralympics. FIFH has also during the years been awarded with titles like Club of the Year in Skåne and Championship club of the Year in Malmö.
