Subject: Players' lounges and accreditation

Dear All,

As you may have already been made aware by your Tournament Director, the policy for player lounge access on the European Tour has been revised for the 2010 Season as follows:

Each member will now only receive one **members' guest** pass for access to the players' lounge for the season and that pass has to be nominated to an individual (e.g. his partner) for the entire season and will be produced with corresponding **photo ID**.

We very much hope that this policy will considerably reduce the pressure on the players' lounges to the benefit of all. In order to properly implement this policy all "Temporary members" and their partners will need to obtain a Photo ID credential from the European Tour office on site.

Whilst we will have a basic facility to produce a photo in the office it will be far less time consuming for all if such players **could arrive on site with a passport sized photo of themselves and their nominated player lounge guest** for this purpose.

Can we please ask therefore that this message is relayed to any Sponsor Invites or Nationally exempt players for your tournament, that are not members of the European Tour in Categories 1-14. All such players should also be advised that **caddies are not allowed into the lounge** unless they are blood relatives.
