



Buenavista June Report Abstract

The golf course is not in good condition overall for the tournament.

Greens are not bad at all but they need more verticutting, sand topdressing and less irrigation. Moreover, some greens are infected with dollar spot. If they follow our recommendations greens will be in good condition for the tournament.

The **tee** platforms reserved for the tournament were not closed the past June 3rd. Some platforms are not leveled.

Fairways have low turfgrass density, a lot of thatch, are yellowish in colour and there is only a little bit difference between fairways and rough. A step-cut of one machine will be not possible for the tournament. So, we will not have an intermediate step of cut between the fairway height of cut and the rough height of cut.

The **rough** is not homogeneous; there is a little bit difference between fairways and rough. Furthermore, there are some weeds all over the rough.

Bunkers are in a very good condition; they only need some manicure care for the tournament.

They also have a problem on the **antegreens**. They decreased the height of cut only in one time. So, three of the antegreens show a very important scalping.

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
