TERMS OF THE OF COMPETITION

Entries:

Being a member of the programme “PEACE&SPORT”, it is open to all those players holding a P&P license from their country. Spanish players must hold an R.F.E.G. valid license.

Upon receiving any registration and before confirming it, the Organization shall inform the Federation / Association / Union to which that pair belongs and obtain its official approval.

Entry Fee:

Registration fee: 40 € per player. This value includes OPEN fee, practice times, Welcome cocktail and Prize – Giving Ceremony.

Registration:

According place of origin the dates to registration are the following:

A) International players:

The first registration deadline will be open until 28th October 2019 at 23:59, remaining accepted the 24 player first-registered.

B) National players:

The first registration deadline will be open until 28th October 2019 at 23:59, remaining accepted the 24 player with lower handicap on the closing date of entry. In the event of a handicap tie, prevail the entry order

C) Organizing Committee: 6 places are reserved

Once the deadline for the submission of registrations has passed, if still have places available, will be covered by players from one or another group until complete the 54 players

Game Format:

-54 Holes Stroke Play

Flags:

In Pitch & Putt (IPPA) courses, flags can be set between a minimum of 40 meters and a maximum of 90 meters. The maximum length of a 18 hole course is 1.200 metres. The Committee and the Tournament Director will decide the position of the flags in each round.

Golf Ball Tee:

Use of a Tee on the Teeing Ground is optional.

The ball tee should follow the Golf Rules, therefore, a bracket or a similar object will be allowed. In case you make use of a bracket or similar object as a bracket rope attached to it, it will be compulsory to have another bracket or similar object on the other end.

The combination of brackets and rope will not be allowed under any circumstances to indicate the direction of the game or to measure wind direction nor wind intensity. Green Book (Libro Verde) Chapter IV, page 22, part g-(d).

Tee-Markers:

Tee Ground limits of each hole are defined by the field of the rug (mat) located in each of them. The ball must be placed just on the carpet. The player can take the stance outside the carpet.

Clubs:

As set by IPPA Regulations, a maximum of 3 (three) clubs (one of which must be a Putter) are permitted for use.

Draws:

The Tournament Committee will establish tee-off timings and pairings.

Caddies:

Caddies are NOT allowed.

Dmd's:

Any type of gadget, laser meter or GPS to measure distances is FORBIDDEN. The Committee will provide the players this information.

Ties:

In the event of tie for the first classified it will be resolved by Play-Off (Sudden death) playing holes 1 and 9 as often as necessary until to get a winner.

For the rest of the cases it will be applied as mentioned in Green Book (Libro Verde) Chapter II, part 6.9(d)a.

Trophies:

- Trophies to the first three classified
- Trophy for first Senior classified
- First Young classified (male/female, born since 2001 and consecutives)
- First Women classified.

Prizes may not be aggregated

Tournament Committee:

The RFEG will designate the Tournament Committee and the Referees.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to decide anything that affects organization and the interpretation of the current terms.

The Tournament Committee can modify the number of registered players and cancel any of the categories.
