EELS - Bronze / Silver / Gold Levels

Dear Jose / Enrique

Since the beginning of 2014, the PGAs of Europe have implemented the European Education Level System (EELS) as the process in which we recognise a member country for the level of education that they deliver to, or approve for, it's members.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the PGA of Spain has been selected for re-evaluation during 2015. The cycle of recognition and re-evaluation lasts for four years, so assuming that we successfully complete recognition of the PGA of Spain in 2015, the next time we will re-assess the education programme will be in 2020. This letter will outline the chronology and the steps to be taken. There is some flexibility in the inspection dates due to the education calendar and so exact timings may be adjusted to suit the local reality.

November 2014: The PGA of Spain to be informed of their selection for re-evaluation. A physical or virtual meeting with the Head of Training from the PGA of Spain to outline the process and answer any relevant questions.

January -March 2015: The PGA of Spain will be supplied with the necessary EELS documents and be given a period of three months to map your education against the learning outcomes which are required for an EELS level at either the Bronze, Silver or Gold level. It will be the decision of the PGA of Spain at which level you would like to be assessed against. Throughout the process the PGAs of Europe Director of Education and Membership, will be available for advice either by email, telephone or virtual meetings.

April - June 2015: Once you have submitted your self assessment an approved assessor will analyse your return and the supporting documents before offering feedback on the suitability to progress to the second stage. You will receive a full report of how the assessor has mapped your submission against the learning outcomes required for the level which has been chosen. Once the desk work has

been satisfactorily completed the PGA of Spain will move to the final stage of assessment.

September - December 2015: An approved inspector will make a two days visit (Europe) to check on the delivery, facilities used, administration and to interview trainers and students.

The costs for the upcoming re-evaluation and inspection visit are as follows, and do not include the travel, accommodation and subsistence expenses of the inspector, which are the responsibility of the PGA of Spain.

Bronze level: €1,500 - Silver level: €1,800 - Gold level: €1,950

The Education Committee and I will be very happy to discuss the above with you at the upcoming PGAs of Europe Annual Congress, where we can arrange a formal appointment on Monday 8th December. If however you would like to discuss the matter before then please feel free to contact me.
